Footnotes

TSUNAMI SALLI shared the lead in hand just off the rail, moved ahead when allowed on the second turn, drifted out to path four entering the lane, continued to gradually drift under right-handed pressure, held a straight path after entering the last sixteenth and shook free. FLITTER FLATTER gradually advanced from paths two or three on the backstretch, was three wide into the second bend, moved to the rail nearing the quarter pole, floated out some into the stretch, threatened with a furlong to go, could not sustain her bid deep stretch but was easily second best. SIX SIXTY raced in contention from inside, failed to keep up while just off the inside on the second turn, lacked the needed stretch bid but took over third late. QUIET OUTLAW contested the pace just outside TSUNAMI SALLI, backed up some leaving the second turn, lost ground staying outside the drifting TSUNAMI SALLI entering the lane, slowly yielded, moved in to be three wide with a furlong left and continued to retreat. QUEEN OF THE MET stumbled at the break, trailed well off the inside on the backstretch, saved ground taking the second turn and improved position some without threatening. HOLY ALLIANCE pressed the pacesetters from outside for more than a half mile but faded four wide on the second bend. B DREAMER steadily retreated from outside on the backstretch, was just off the rail taking the second turn, floated out entering the stretch, distanced herself from the rest and was walked off.
