**Footnotes**

MIAMI ICE settled along or just off the inside, picked up his pace after six furlongs, swung four wide for the second bend, rallied under a drive in the lane, took over nearing the sixteenth marker and began to draw off. GOLDFINDER vied for the early lead between rivals, moved clear just off the inside on the first turn, steadily opened up on the field once on the backstretch, was put to a drive leaving the second bend, all out through the stretch, did not have enough left in the late going but was clearly second best. BALTIC VERSE chase from outside, was four wide taking the first bend, made his move three wide on the second turn and gained second, angled in some for the stretch run, was no match for the top pair but held off SEFALANAU under steady handling. SEFALANAU gradually progressed from inside, came off the rail some on the second bend, was three wide into the lane, altered outside BALTIC VERSE upper stretch but could not get past that one in the waning yards. E DREAMER well back and well of the inside through the early going, commenced his bid just off the rail on the second turn, angled out four wide upper stretch and passed tired ones without threatening. TIO CHENCHO a contender between rivals the first half mile, failed to stay close while maintaining third on the backstretch, was just off the inside on the second bend, took the rail into the stretch and yielded. SIR REDFORD just off the inside for more than six furlongs, lost position while taking the second turn three then four wide and had no late bid. INDY KINGS DANCER was soon well back and also well off the inside, moved in to be just off the rail entering the second turn, swung widest for the stretch run and had little to offer. ROARING REX away slowly, trailed while saving ground, floated out to path three into the lane and lacked a rally. CORNEL NOBLE chased the early speed from along the rail to the second bend then gave way.
