T BILL BUBBLE kept close, was three wide on the bend, fanned out further into the stretch, took over inside the final sixteenth and began to draw off nearing the wire. CART'S GLITTER awkward at the break, advanced from outside, moved in beside WHY NORTH on the turn, gained a slight advantage inside the last furlong but did not have enough left deep stretch. WHY NORTH drifted out a bit and bumped with LITTLE LUCK shortly after the break, disputed the pace from inside but slowly yielded inside the final furlong. DEW DETIME angled out on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a significant bid. CITY WIFE lugged in some to also bump LITTLE LUCK shortly after the start, backed up widest on the turn and had no late bid. HONKY TONK GOLD caught in tight quarters two wide early in the bend, was checked, floated out shortly after that, was just off the rail leaving the bend and had little to offer for the drive. LITTLE LUCK squeezed briefly shortly after the start, gradually angled in entering the turn and flattened the last eighth. PRINCIPAL BALANCE soon trailed from outside, moved to the rail on the turn, angled back out upper stretch for a clear path but had no late bid.
