Footnotes

BOIS D'ARC FOREST bumped and checked shortly after the start, progressed between horses, swung four wide into the second turn, angled in some as he vied for the lead leaving that bend, bumped with UNO MACHO MAN at the top of the lane, gradually moved ahead, was clear entering the final sixteenth and narrowly held off GIVING POINTS under steady urging. GIVING POINTS advanced along the rail on the backstretch, was in tight quarters early in the second turn, altered out four wide inside the final furlong, closed well, came up short but was easily second best. UNO MACHO MAN progressed between horses to share the lead three wide on the backstretch, angled in some on the second turn, bumped with BOIS D'ARC FOREST at the head of the stretch then gradually yielded. RAP ON FELIX settled inside, commenced his bid after a half mile, was blocked and steadied behind traffic leaving the second turn, remained along the rail, had a clear path midstretch but could only improve position without threatening. MADMADSKILLZ was sent to contest the pace from inside, could not keep up leaving the second turn, angled out four wide upper stretch, continued to gradually fade and drifted out late. ARTEMUS JOY drifted out some to bump BOIS D'ARC FOREST shortly after the start, made up ground just off the inside on the backstretch, was blocked two wide leaving the second bend, swung five wide entering the lane, lacked a significant bid and was altered in when he lost his path with a sixteenth to go. OH MY POSH without early speed, gradually advanced four wide to have a striking position on the second turn, fanned out further into the stretch, began to tire and was forced out in the late going. JAMAICA LANE prominent from outside, was three wide on the second bend but gave way from between rivals leaving that turn. ELECTRIC STRIDE stayed well off the inside throughout and failed to menace. TOP ROCK SOUTH displayed early speed between rivals but quit three wide on the second turn.
