Footnotes

KOHL'S CROCK bumped with MARY ANN'SMOMENT at the start, vied for the early lead from outside, edged ahead and stayed in paths two and three through the turn, under a steady drive in the lane and held on. MARY ANN'SMOMENT bumped with KOHL'S CROCK at the break, was kept close from outside, advanced three wide on the bend, drifted out to path five into the stretch, hung in the late going but was unchallenged for second. LA WOLFIE away slowly, advanced inside, failed to stay close along the rail on the turn, fanned out to path three for the stretch run, lacked the needed late bid but took over third late. HILLSIDE SUNRISE was well placed early inside, backed up on the turn, advanced along the rail to regain a striking position midstretch but wore down the last sixteenth. COLVILLE ZEAL dueled for the lead just inside KOHL'S CROCK, was just off the rail on the bend and flattened out two wide through the stretch. GRANDE JETE was a brief contender between horses but gave way three wide on the turn. VILLA VERNELL backed out of contention going to the turn, four wide on the bend, drifted out to the middle of the track into the stretch and had little left. GOLD SPOT broke awkwardly, was soon taken outside, angled in some leaving the turn and no late bid.
