ILLINI DESTINY broke alertly, shared the early lead between rivals, floated out some into the lane then steadily opened up under a drive. RIGGIN SLINGER hesitated then swiped the gate breaking inward, moved up quickly just off the inside, was boxed in entering the bend, got through three wide near the quarter pole, in path four at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner but lasted for the place under a steady drive. TOUGH SAM away slowly, was blocked early, forced to angle seven wide for a clear path into the turn, lost considerable ground through the bend, failed to close the gap the last furlong but was clearly best of the rest. CANARY KID hesitated at the start then altered in to avoid POP'S SKY TRAINER, advanced just off the rail on the turn, fought for third upper stretch but could not sustain his bid late. PORTERVILLE displayed early speed between rivals, three wide on the bend, drifted out to path six for the stretch run, began to fade and returned bleeding from the nostrils. IRON WILL SUMMIT was an early contender toward the outside, could not keep up while forced to stay five wide on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and had little to offer. POP'S SKY TRAINER broke inward, raced in the second flight between rivals but gave way four wide on the bend. CHRIS AND JADE was a brief factor outside but faded six wide on the turn and hand ridden through the lane. SCATARIA, hard sent to dispute the pace inside, gave way along the rail through the stretch.
