Footnotes

SILVA CAT rated from inside, swung out widest leaving the bend, gained the advantage inside the last furlong and shook off FIELD GOAL nearing the wire. FIELD GOAL in the second flight between horses, fanned five wide for the stretch run, gained a brief lead midstretch, tried hard to stay with SILVA CAT inside the last furlong, did not have enough late but was clearly second best. SEFALANAU gradually angled in on the backstretch, progressed behind GOLD DE LAC on the turn and upper stretch, altered inside the latter after entering the final furlong and caught GOLD DE LAC for third near the finish. GOLD DE LAC without early speed just off the inside, improved position along the rail on the bend, progressed through the stretch, floated out a bit inside the last eighth, fought for third but was narrowly outfinished. GRUDGE MATCH broke on top and outward, vied for the lead from outside, was two wide on the bend, floated out to path four into the stretch and gradually yielded. LINE I ONE a step slow at the break, rushed up from inside to contest the pace, came off the rail some entering the lane and began to tire. MAPLE AVENUE an early factor from outside, faded four wide on the bend. OSCEORO angled just outside the early speed on the backstretch, was two then three wide taking the turn and also wore down for the drive.
