Footnotes

UPPER NINETY vied for the lead between rivals, moved ahead into the bend, gradually opened up and held sway under a mild drive in the stretch. PRAIRIE PRINCE chased from midpack well off the inside, moved to the rail entering the turn, was all out in the stretch, gradually closed the gap and moved clear for second in the waning yards. EVERSEEONEOF THESE in contention early, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for the drive, ran evenly and narrowly held on for third. COGNITION hustled along from outside, could not stay close to UPPER NINETY while three wide on the bend, floated out some for the drive and lacked the extra needed deep stretch. MYLES MCD prominent between rivals, was caught in tight quarters two wide nearing the quarter mile, began to fade, moved outside COGNITION upper stretch and also finished evenly. WESTERN ZEN without speed from between rivals, fanned out five wide for the drive and had no late bid. POLAR EXPEDITION just off the inside, failed to menace. FASTER N GRACIE was soon well back, angled in on the bend and proved empty for the drive. SOUTHERN DREAMER a bit slow at the start, showed no speed, though urged along, saved ground and had little to offer in the lane.
