**Footnotes**

NAFIR'S BEST bumped at the start, was hustled up just off the inside, two wide on the bend, fanned to path four into the lane, closed well under steady urging and got up in time. TRUST MORE steadily angled in while hustled along in the early going, was two wide on the turn, moved clear entering the stretch, gradually wore down in the late going and was outfinished in a game effort. IMMINENT STORM in midpack between horses, was three wide on the turn, lost ground when swung widest into the lane, steadily progressed, came up short but was clearly best of the rest. TAXES checked when his path narrowed after travelling the first eighth, advanced from inside on the turn, altered out three wide midstretch and continued to close the gap. ANTHONY'S PRAYER in contention toward the outside, was three to five wide through the turn and lacked a significant stretch response. FROSTED RHYTHM forwardly placed from the early going, saved ground through the bend then wore down inside the final furlong. CONIR improved position from inside on the turn, came off the rail some entering the lane then had to alter out then back in to avoid traffic inside the last eighth. KATE'DISTRICT broke outward, bumping NAFIR'S BEST then was forced in by that one leaving the chute, was soon moved outside, just off the rail taking the turn and lacked a stretch bid. RUSTY'S RED BOY chased from outside and had little left four wide leaving the bend. SEMI PRO displayed early speed between horses, had the rail on the turn, could not stay with TRUST MORE leaving the bend, moved outside that one at the head of the lane, gave way between rivals and gradually drifted out the last furlong.
