Footnotes

OUST caught in crowding shortly after the start, progressed toward the outside on the backstretch, swung out further nearing the second turn, advanced four wide, slowly gained on SMOKEY AROMA in the lane, gained a slight advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and gradually edged ahead in the waning yards. SMOKEY AROMA soon had the lead, showed the way just off or along the rail in hand, was roused leaving the second turn, all out in the stretch, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. PALACE TENOR prominent between horses from the early going, began to back up just off the inside on the second turn, swung out some for the stretch run, battled to keep third and narrowly held his position. WILL'S HONEY in contention, as well, between rivals, failed to keep up three wide on the second turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. SUNDAY SAINT also forwardly placed early, saved ground taking the second bend, dueled for third in the stretch but began to wear down the final sixteenth. FUTURISTIC gradually progressed from between horses, followed WILL'S HONEY through the second turn, altered outside that one upper stretch but ran evenly to the wire. KEYSTONE KID bumped and steadied slightly at the start, trailed, advanced along the rail on the second turn, fanned out some entering the stretch and improved position a bit. SEYRULE steadied along from inside when his path narrowed shortly after entering the backstretch, saved ground through the second bend, came off the rail some for a clear path upper stretch but weakened in the late going. THE ALCOVIA KID bumped with KEYSTONE KID at the break, stayed well off the inside and showed little. BLACKHAWK RED five wide on the first turn, was a factor from outside on the backstretch but quit three wide nearing the end of five furlongs.
