Footnotes

ABESI broke first, was rated off the rail, advanced behind TIFFANY TOWER on the turn, quickly took over outside that one when asked at the head of the lane, drew clear, lugged in to the rail near the eighth pole and widened her lead under a steady left whip the final furlong. YOU'RE SO LUCKY was angled in early, took the turn just off the rail, swung out for a clear path in the stretch, provided a mild bid four wide, failed to make up ground the last eighth but pulled clear for second in the late going. TIFFANY TOWER set a pressured pace just off the rail, was no match for ABESI in the stretch, angled outside that one near the furlong marker and wore down late to just last for third. STAR STRETCHER broke outward, was checked, failed to menace racing wide but was closing in on TIFFANY TOWER late. TRADE N TREASURE steadily faded inside. MANHATTAN MOMENT dwelt at the start, spotting the field many lengths and showed little in a ground-saving trip. REPLY N ACES contested the pace from outside, started to drift out on the turn, lost further ground entering the stretch, was eased late and walked off.
