Footnotes

ALTRISTA broke alertly, was rated on the front end from inside, let out leaving the bend and steadily opened up under a drive deep stretch. FRISKAWAY without early speed from outside, was caught six wide into the bend, angled inside midway on the turn then steadily advanced along the rail in the stretch to gain second late. ONE MORE TAP steadied in traffic shortly after entering the main track, was four wide on the turn, lost ground when forced to fan to path seven into the stretch, battled for second inside the late eighth but started to drift under a left whip in the waning yards and was narrowly outfinished. SILENT RETREAT boxed in behind the pacesetter, gained a clear path two wide upper stretch, moved ahead for second, battled to the wire to hold his position but did not have enough left. NOBLE BEAU advanced from inside on the turn, swung four wide for room into the stretch and ran evenly to the wire. MONARCH THUNDER raced in the second flight just outside SILENT RETREAT, was three wide entering the lane and gradually yielded. NATHAN CHICAGO a factor between rivals on the backstretch, failed to keep up just off the rail on the turn, fanned five wide for the stretch run and continued to fade. LIONELONTHETRACKS void of speed, was widest taking the turn and had no late bid. GET READY HATERS raced with NATHAN CHICAGO from just outside on the backstretch but faded three wide on the bend. LOGOLD'S LUCK was soon far back, stayed well off the inside throughout and showed little.
