SWEET LEMON CHELLO was quickly clear, soon had the inside, showed the way in hand, was roused leaving the second bend, lengthened her lead, under steady urging the last furlong and held off NIKALUK. The latter, steadied back from tight quarters nearing the first turn, was rated three wide on the backstretch and second turn, all out in the stretch, closed but a bit too late. SEANS SILVERDANCER pressed the early speed from just outside, had every chance through the stretch but ran evenly. DUNDALK DUST bumped shortly after the break, progressed off the inside, improved position three wide on the second turn but leveled off the last quarter mile. LIMEHOUSE DANCER drifted out just after the start to bump WONDER COUNTRY, raced in the second flight from inside but gave way just off the rail on the second turn. WONDER COUNTRY bumped and forced out into DUNDALK DUST just after the start, showed no speed, moved to the outside on the backstretch, stayed there and showed little.
