Footnotes

CAMPO JOTI pressed from inside, was caught in tight along the rail on the bend, angled out nearing the quarter pole, split rivals three wide into the lane, moved clear inside the final furlong and held sway under a mild drive. ALGONQUIN POSSE boxed in between rivals, brushed with CAMPO JOTTI while just off the rail on the turn, did not keep up with that one nearing the quarter pole, altered inside shortly after that, was blocked upper stretch, gradually altered out, gained a clear path four wide inside the final furlong and took over second with a sixteenth left. ITZACOLDCASE settled outside, was widest through the bend and found best stride too late. CAMAGIN disputed the pace between horses from the beginning, was just off the inside on the bend and gradually yielded deep stretch. KEL'S DREAMER pressed from outside, was three then four wide taking the turn and slowly weakened for the drive. FOXIE'S SLY WON vied for the lead between horses, gained the rail into the turn and also did not have enough left in the lane. SWIFT MELVA failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. MAGNIFICENT MANDY crowded shortly after leaving the chute, moved out widest with five furlongs to go, stayed well off the inside and had little to offer in the stretch.
