Footnotes

WESTERN FUN kept close, was roused just off the inside leaving the turn, took over upper stretch and was driven clear. BRASSY'S BLESSING without early speed, picked up his pace widest through the turn then drew away for second deep stretch. GRANT H broke on top and inward, gradually backed up, was just off the rail on the turn, angled out for room upper stretch, progressed between horses and gained third late. GREAT WELL was soon clear, saved ground then tired for the drive. BRAVE ANY BATTLE broke outward, raced in contention from outside, faded three wide on the turn, fanned widest for the drive and ran evenly. SHINE NASHLY SHINE was away slowly, advanced from inside on the turn but flattened out just off the rail in the stretch. OCEAN AFLEET forced in at the break, soon retreated, was just off the inside taking the turn, moved to the rail upper stretch and had no late bid. MAKE MIKE SMILE also away slowly, saved ground, failed to menace and had to squeeze through along the rail deep stretch. ABIGCHOICE void of speed from outside, was in path three taking the turn and was empty for the drive.
