Footnotes

DAKOTA'S COURT was settled outside, progressed four and five wide through the bend, took over inside the final furlong and was driven clear. CIRCLETHERUNWAY without early speed, was three wide leaving the bend, had to weave through traffic to advance in the lane, split rivals three wide in the waning yards and gained the place. WINDY CITY RICHIE shared the lead from between rivals, moved clear and took the rail on the turn but wore down inside the last eighth. MABEEMORE forwardly placed between horses, did not keep up four wide leaving the bend and slowly yielded deep stretch. SMITTY displayed early speed from inside, could not stay with WINDY CITY RICHIE on the bend, came off the rail some for the drive and gradually retreated. JESUIT WARRIOR chased from between horses, was three wide leaving the turn, angled outside after entering the last furlong but had no late bid. SPATZEL was soon well back, just off the rail on the turn, also came three wide into the lane, altered out widest inside the final eighth and improved position without threatening. THACKER HENRY a bit erratic from inside while appearing to try to drift out in the early going, was checked in close quarters early in the turn, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and passed a couple tired rivals. TWINE chased from inside then gave way two wide on the turn. HOPPY'S LONG SHOT moved to the inside on the bend as he began to tire and steadily gave way.
