Footnotes

LADY RISS disputed the pace outside from the beginning, was carried out into the stretch, battled under a drive in the lane, lost the whip leaving the furlong marker but edged clear a sixteenth of a mile out and held sway under steady handling. ZITLALY vied for the lead between horses from the beginning, drifted out into the stretch, battled under a left whip, hung late but was easily second best. GOWITHFATE was angled inward leaving the chute trying to stay clear of WELL FROSTED, jostled with GLORIOUS MORN for a few yards, raced in the second flight from inside, lacked a rally three out in the stretch but took over third leaving midstretch and held her position under steady urging. BUCKLE UP CART chased the pacesetters from outside, advanced three wide on the turn, was fanned further into the stretch and also failed to have a late bid outside LADY RISS. OUTTA THE WAY, roughed up between horses just after the start, was checked back, advanced just off the rail on the turn, angled outside WELL FROSTED leaving midstretch and advanced late without threatening. WELL FROSTED lugged in shortly after the start, set a pressured pace from inside through the turn but flattened out in the lane. GLORIOUS MORN broke inward, bumped with OUTTA THE WAY, was forced into that one shortly afterward, jostled with her for position leaving the chute and showed little in her race. ILLINI BOOGY QUEEN failed to menace in a wide trip. IMA CARTWHEEL, jostled about leaving the chute, steadily faded inside and was unresponsive to the whip in the stretch.
