REPLY N ACES broke in stride, disputed the pace from outside, drew off on the turn and continued to open up on the field in the lane under a late whip. YOU'RE SO LUCKY hesitated and then broke in the air, was hustled along, advanced between rivals and got up for second late four wide. STAR STRETCHER bumped at the start, steadily progressed between horses, took the turn three wide, drifted out in the stretch but caught IS FAAAAAST for third late. IS FAAAAAST drifted out leaving the chute, battled or the early lead from just off the rail, gave futile chase in the lane and began to wear down in the deep stretch. SEA GULCH SALLY raced in contention briefly along the rail, failed to keep up on the turn and flattened out under mild urging in the stretch. HEAVENLY KISSES broke outward, bumping STAR STRETCHER, failed to menace three to four wide but passed tired ones in the stretch. BON GIORNO was never a factor in a wide trip. TALCULATION steadily faded inside. NINETY MILE ISLAND showed little four to five wide.
