SWEET LILLIAN stayed outside CHIEF'S GIRL to the backstretch, drew clear when let out, put to a drive in the upper stretch and was much the best while kept to task to the waning yards. PRETTY GRETA was unhurried off the rail early, steadied briefly as CHIEF'S GIRL dropped back into her path going to the second turn, advanced between horses shortly thereafter and gave futile chase outside SWEET LILLIAN the last quarter mile. BEALE ST. was never close in a ground-saving trip and could only pass tired ones in the lane to gain the show. DAWN'S DARLING never threatened in an outside trip. CHIEF'S GIRL vied for the lead briefly inside on the first turn, proved no match for SWEET LILLIAN on the backstretch, faded after a half mile and was allowed to coast outside in the drive.
