CJ'S SUNSHINE broke alertly, set the pace outside, drew off under urging through the turn and was unchallenged under a left whip through the stretch. SLEW THE CITY hit the gate at the start, was hustled up outside and closed the gap on the winner late from five wide. DIAMOND JOE never threatened racing evenly three and four wide. CANYON DE ORO, void of speed, angled out on the turn and passed beaten ones six wide through the stretch . DOAKS CREEK backed up four wide on the turn and lugged in through the stretch. I WANTA BE ALONE stumbled at the start, angled out on the turn and only improved his position from the middle of the track through the stretch. I'M NEXT chased the pace from just off the rail for four furlongs and gave way. NICCOLA steadily faded inside.
