Footnotes

CANYON DE ORO stalked the pace from outside, was put to the whip on the second turn, under a long drive six wide through the stretch, caught SLEW THE CITY at the seventy yard marker and was beginning to draw off. SLEW THE CITY was sent up outside to get the lead leaving the first turn, moved clear under hand urging off the rail on the backstretch, was all out four wide in the drive but outfinished. ADAMS PEAK was settled toward the outside on the backstretch, picked up his pace and angled in some going to the second turn, commenced his bid three wide into the stretch, took over third, drifted out near the eighth pole, failed to make up ground late but was clearly best of the rest. STATE FLAG broke alertly, was hustled along but outrun on the first turn, moved outside SLEW THE CITY on the backstretch, advanced five wide on the second turn but lacked a response outside in the drive. SPANISH CHARM backed up between rivals on the backstretch, saved ground through the second turn, fanned out into the stretch but failed to response four wide. STYLISH IN RED was not a factor in an outside trip. JOE KELLYS TUNE failed to respond to the whip three wide on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn but had little to offer in the lane. DIAMOND JOE forced the pace two wide for a half but faltered leaving the turn and was eased late. CEEZ backed up inside and was eased the final furlong.
