Footnotes

CANDY AND THUNDER chased outside a rival, moved up three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, bid three deep under left handed urging, gained the lead past the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed. MY SELECTION sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back between foes through the final sixteenth and continued willingly to the wire. TORNADO ALLIE saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside in the drive and went on gamely to the end. RIVER KISS stumbled at the start, stalked three deep then a bit off the rail, was between horses into the second turn, came out some in the stretch and was outfinished. SWEET NOTHINGS allowed to settle off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TIPPING POINT between horses early, stalked outside a rival, went three deep into the second turn, dropped back between foes leaving that turn and weakened. DON'TGETMADALEXIS off a bit slowly, chased just out from the rail, angled in on the second turn and did not rally.
