KISSIN PARTY never far back, tracked the leaders from the inside, inched up, remained inside and kicked clear at mid stretch. SUM MISTAKE race very wide through the first turn, shifted in through the backstretch, saved ground through the final turn and followed the winner to the wire. LA MANDONNA was off a step slow, lagged to the final turn and rallied strongly four wide to be up for the show. TRIBAL PRINCESS sprinted to the lead before the first turn, set all the pace to the furlong pole while racing off the rail and weakened late. LADY LESSIE was slow into stride, lagged to the final turn, came three wide and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. JUMP ROPE GIRL rushed up in the early going, went wide through the first turn and the gave out in the lane. HOW SWEET IT IS attended the pace until turning for home, loomed dangerously, then stopped. GONE CALIFORNIAN bid six wide in the final turn and had nothing more.
