Footnotes

J AND S EXPRESS chased a bit off the rail, moved up outside a rival into and on the second turn, came under some urging then had the rider lose the whip leaving that turn, bid four wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, drifted in and won clear under energetic handling. FILLY POWER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, fought back between foes in upper stretch and held second. PRINCESS SUANCES sent inside then pulled and came off the rail approaching the first turn, stalked the pace, angled in for the second turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. DELILAH JONES drifted out some into the first turn, stalked off the rail, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, dueled outside a foe on the second turn, battled three wide between horses in upper stretch and weakened some but was edged for third. WOODMAN'S LASS drifted out some into the first turn, stalked just off the fence, bid between horses leaving the backstretch, was in a bit tight and shuffled back into the second turn, bid again along the rail in upper stretch and weakened late. WHOLE ENCHILADA angled in nearing the first turn and saved ground to no avail.
