Footnotes

MARK OF A WARRIOR pulled between horses into and on the first turn and steadied early on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. STRIKING SPIRIT (GB) stalked off the rail, bid between horses into and on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead past the eighth pole and held on gamely but was edged late. HAMMURABI four wide early, stalked outside, bid three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and held third. RAINGEAR settled inside then a bit off the rail, went around a rival into the stretch, came out some and just missed the show. AFLEET DEAL saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. WAY TOO MUCH chased off the inside or alongside a rival, swung out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. NUTMEG NED sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail into and on the

second turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late. MACK'S GOLD BULLET four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. SPICY BEAU drifted out into the first turn, angled back to the rail and saved ground to no avail. ROMAN GUITAR pulled outside rivals then angled in some, took up sharply, came out and clipped heels into the first turn, angled in and was done early.
