L. A. WEEKEND hustled between horses early, angled in and set all the pace inside, drew off in the stretch under some urging and steady handling late. LA MANO NERA drifted out and steadied early on the first turn, moved up three deep on the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. WHY NOT BE PERFECT saved ground chasing the pace throughout and picked up the show. ERIC THE RAM forced out into the first turn, angled in and chased alongside a rival, found the rail on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. NIGHT TIDE also forced out into the first turn, chased three deep then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SOLAR ROCKET came off the inside leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, angled out into the stretch and also weakened. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) came out when in tight off heels early on the first turn, angled in leaving that turn then saved ground to no avail. YANKEE DAN drifted out and steadied on the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, continued three wide on the second turn and weakened.
