Footnotes

ME MY MINE dueled three deep then outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the second turn and held gamely under strong handling. STORMIN AWAY stalked inside, bid outside leaving the backstretch, stalked outside a foe on the second turn and came back on late. FLORIDA KEYS saved ground chasing the pace, moved up leaving the backstretch, split horses into the second turn, continued inside in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip past the eighth pole and clearly bested the others. SUNDAY TIMES stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn and weakened. APALACHEE TIGER bobbled at the start, had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn and steadied in tight, had the rider lose the whip into the stretch, then came out and also weakened. ROYAL PRICE (GER) between foes early, chased outside or off the rail and did not rally. YES HE'S A PISTOL dueled between horses early, dropped back in the stretch the first time, gave way and was eased.
