**Footnotes**

NEGRA TOMASA chased a bit off the rail, swung out leaving the final turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. QUIET ADVICE between foes early, chased three deep then off the rail, bid four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, battled outside a rival in the drive, briefly put a head in front in deep stretch but could not match the winner late. CEE'S THE YEAR four wide early, angled in between foes on the first turn, found the inside on the middle turn, continued just off the rail, bid three wide nearing the final turn, gained the advantage on that turn, battled off the rail in the stretch and held third. DERBY MEMO settled outside a rival then inside, came out again on the middle turn, angled three deep into the stretch, cut to the inside a sixteenth out and was edged for the show. FIESTA EXPRESS chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. KIT CAT KITTY broke slowly, settled inside then off the rail, went up four wide on the final turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. WARREN'S PERFORMER angled in and dueled outside a rival then between horses into and on the final turn and weakened. ON TIME AGAIN a bit slow to begin, went up inside to the early lead, dueled along the rail, fought back into and on the last turn, dropped back approaching the stretch and also weakened.
