Footnotes

EVENING ISLAND chased between horses then outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and wore down foes under urging three wide on the line. BIG WAGS stalked off the rail or outside a rival, bid alongside CAYAMBE on the final turn, battled outside that one through a long drive and continued gamely between foes on the wire. CAYAMBE sped to the early lead then stalked a bit off the inside, bid alongside a rival to gain the advantage on the middle turn, inched away, set the pace just off the fence, fought back inside the runner-up through a stiff drive, continued gamely under urging in deep stretch and had the rider lose the whip on the line. DEPUTIFORMER saved ground chasing the pace, split horses on the final turn, angled back to the inside and lacked the needed late kick. BRONZE FOX chased four wide then outside on the last backstretch, dropped back on the final turn and gave way. OHANA SPIRIT chased three deep between horses, angled in approaching the final turn and also gave way. JAIRZIHNO (GB) sent between foes early, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail in the stretch the first time and on the middle turn, dropped back on the backstretch and had nothing left for the stretch.
