GUTSHOT STRAIGHT stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, bumped with a rival on a short lead in upper stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. YANKEE BRAVO saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went around a rival into the second turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and continued willingly. BUYER'S REMORSE three deep on the first turn, chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out in the stretch and finished with interest. CAUGHT A FLYER had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, battled along the inside on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened some late. SPEED BIAS sent inside to duel for the lead, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch, re-bid between foes into the second turn, bumped with the winner and fought back between horses in upper stretch and also weakened a bit late. AFLEET DEAL angled in and stalked the pace inside, fell back into the second turn and weakened. VOLCANIC ICE allowed to settle off the rail or outside a rival and failed to menace.
