WARREN'S MAD DAWG sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, met the bid of the runner-up on the turn, inched away nearing the stretch and drew off under a brisk hand ride until the final strides. JESSAKAR stumbled at the start, went up between horses early, bid alongside the winner on the turn, was not a match for that one in the stretch and just held second inside. ADDISON'S HONOR chased outside then alongside a rival and split horses at the wire for the show. EVELYN TROUBLE between horses early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the turn and also went between foes on the line. BELLA MARINO broke a bit slowly and steadied in tight early, came off the rail on the backstretch, angled out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award four wide at the finish. WILD BELLA sent between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. ELLENSONG broke out a bit, was between rivals early, settled off the rail and did not rally. GREGARIOUS GAL stalked inside, dropped back into the turn and weakened.
