Footnotes

JAKEY BOY bumped at the start, settled outside a rival, split horses into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging while being bumped soundly at the wire but got up. MY COUNT SILVER dueled three deep then outside a rival, took the lead and inched away on the second turn, kicked clear, drifted out under left handed urging to bump the winner while being caught on the line. EXPENSIVE PENS between foes early, chased outside or off the rail, bid three deep into the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. SI ES VERDAD chased inside, split horses leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. SACRED GHOST dwelt to be away well behind the field, settled outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and improved position. CRISPY COREY angled in outside a rival then saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and weakened. CHI CHA CHA between horses early, angled in and dueled inside, stalked on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. VALENTINE JOE settled inside, drifted out sharply into the first turn, went outside a rival on the second turn and did not rally. JACK OF PLUNDER had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, dropped back nearing the second turn and weakened. SNOWBALLS bumped and crowded at the start, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and failed to menace.
