Footnotes

BANISH THE BLUES had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back in the stretch and inched away late under urging. ZEE TOPPER chased inside, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, battled outside the winner on the final turn and in the stretch but could not quite match strides late. TURKISH SCOUT chased a bit off the rail then between horses, went up outside a rival on the last turn and gained the show. DON PESO drifted wide on the first turn, settled off the rail, angled in for the final turn and lacked the needed rally. MINERA saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail in the drive and improved position but was not a threat. ZAMIDEAR lugged out on the first turn, chased outside and lacked a response in the stretch. COLLEGE EDUCATION stalked off the rail then bid outside the winner and dueled for command, dropped back into the second turn, angled in and gave way. SILKEN BONDS saved ground off the pace, came out on the final turn and also gave way. CHOICE CAVIAR chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, had the saddle slip in the stretch the first turn, dropped back and was eased in the stretch. CONTINENTALMEETING flipped and fell behind the gate before the start, drifted wide and dropped back on the first turn and was eased before reaching the second turn.
