SUMMER SURVIVOR dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, met the bid of that foe in the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. BLAZE IT had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid alongside the winner in the stretch but could not match that one late. YES HE'S A PISTOL hesitated then broke a bit in the air and slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and finished well. MOON MISSION allowed to settle inside then outside a rival and lacked the needed rally. JAMAICANMELATE pulled early, angled in and stalked inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. SKIMMING BYE settled outside then angled in on the first turn, chased between foes on the backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. LOWER SHORE chased outside a rival then tree deep on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and weakened.
