NO CAPS NO FLOORS stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter in the stretch to gain the lead and proved best under steady handling. PROUD HILLBILLY prompted the pace three deep then stalked between rivals, came three wide into the stretch and was second best. EDDIE THE HAT dueled inside, kicked clear on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and held third. OL'DOGTOWN chased outside then three deep, steadied and was forced out a bit leaving the turn, angled inward in the stretch and lacked a rally. WISEST CAT chased between horses then off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. BLUSHING ROMAN dueled between horses then outside a rival, drifted wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SAKE BOMB hopped slightly at the start, settled outside, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. ETHIOPIAN broke slowly, settled inside throughout and failed to menace.
