CRIMSON STAR chased outside, moved up three deep on the backstretch, bid outside a rival in the stretch to gain the lead and won clear under some urging. FOR CONTRAST dueled outside a rival then kicked clear, angled in on the second turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch and was second best. BYE NOW broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, continued inside while moving up on the second turn and bested the rest. EXCESSTROUBLE threw his head and steadied early, settled inside, moved up outside then four wide on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. SWISS LAD angled in and settled off the rail then inside, split horses leaving the backstretch, steadied into the second turn and did not rally. SEMPAI stalked inside, dropped back on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. SOCK IT TO 'EM pulled early and dueled a bit off the rail then stalked inside and weakened. BIG SWISS chased between horses then inside on the second turn and also weakened. C MY SECRET stalked three deep then outside, steadied between horses into the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
