Footnotes

AGGRAVATED BATTERY sped to the early lead, angled in and set all the pace off the rail, drifted out into and through the stretch and won clear under some urging and steady handling late. COOKIE RULES unhurried and angled in to save ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place late. DIPLO chased outside or alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for third. LUCERO NEGRO was in a good position chasing the pace outside or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and was edged for the show. SENOR CRAFTY stalked inside then between foes leaving the backstretch, came outside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CHARMING JIG chased outside a rival, advanced three deep leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. JAKE'S MANDATE stalked outside a rival, steadied between horses into the second turn, angled in leaving that turn and weakened. BOSTON BAKED BEAN sent inside to chase the pace, saved ground and lacked a rally. DIPSEA DEMON allowed to settle a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. MARK'S HALO stalked outside a rival then inside, dropped back on the second turn and weakened.
