ROYAL CHAVELA bumped at the start, drifted out on the first turn, chased outside a rival, bid four wide into the second turn, angled in and took the lead into the stretch, drifted to the inside and won clear under some urging. TRIBAL MAGIC had good early speed, angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and held the place. TEMPEST ARIA chased outside a rival or off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and gained the show, then was unsaddled at the half mile pole and vanned off. SUANCES STAR drifted out on the first turn, chased outside a rival, bid three deep between foes into the second turn, angled in some leaving that turn and was edged for third. HOMEWORK chased inside throughout and lacked the needed rally. MINT CITY fractious in the post parade and reluctant to load, had speed outside, dueled alongside a rival then between foes on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and was not persevered with late. PRINCESS BANDINI bumped at the start, settled off the rail then dropped back inside and failed to menace. CLEAR THE SET broke out and bumped the winner, drifted out on the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, blew the second turn and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run on the second turn before ruling CLEAR THE SET was the cause of her own trouble.
