APACHE ANNIE went up four wide in the run to the first turn, dueled three deep then outside a rival, kicked clear and angled in on the second turn and proved best under urging. HAVENS LAKE angled in and dueled between horses on the first turn then inside on the backstretch, stalked the winner leaving the second turn and bested the others. TOO PINK pulled between foes in a bit tight nearing the first turn, was shuffled back some into the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just got the show. SCRATCHTHEMOON pulled inside also in a bit tight early, split horses into the backstretch to chase the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and was edged late for third. CHULIHMA settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and was not a threat. HANAGAN MEADOW pressed then stalked the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened. FOR LINDA chased three deep then outside a rival, also dropped back leaving the second turn, took an awkward step into the stretch and gave way.
