TYSPIKESHIGH was never far back, came inside through the first turn, shifted out in the middle of the backstretch, rallied three wide and was pulling away at the end. RAZOR CUT rushed up to duel with Mr. Excessive to the head of the stretch, assumed a short lead and flattened. STAR TRICK lagged while saving ground through the first turn, inched up through the backstretch and closed willingly for the show. BIG HIT broke alertly, was pushed out wide through the first turn, dropped back and then came again through the lane without menacing the top three. MR. EXCESSIVE immediately sprinted to the front, set all the pace for a half mile and gradually weakened. BIG BOY COLE raced in the middle of the pack and did not rally. COLORKINETIC showed very brief speed. MAKACK showed little. HOME GAME was away a step slow, took an awkward step in the first turn, remained last, fell in the middle of the final turn and was vanned off.
