SPARK OF DUBAI allowed to settle soon after the start, was content to lag through the backstretch, responded when asked through the final turn and was all out to prevail in a well timed rally. STELLA'S POSADA broke well, sped into a contentious duel before the initial turn, was fanned out wide through the first turn to lose some momentum, regained his stride, edged up on the leader, took command a furlong from home but was unable to hold off the fast closing winner. BITTER BILL chased the leaders from the start, came two wide through the second turn and flattened just when more was needed. HURRY UP AUSTIN broke awkwardly, lagged to the final turn and showed some late interest without menacing the top ones. ASHPASS raced in the middle of the pack and could not rally. BOXELDER showed good speed for a half mile and came up empty. YES TALK TO ME was away alertly, pushed STELLA'S POSADA out through the first turn, gained command early in the backstretch but stopped in the middle of the final turn.
