Footnotes

ACTION IN MAY between horses early, stalked inside, moved up a bit off the rail, bid outside the runner-up leaving the final turn, gained the lead past the eighth pole and proved best under a moderate hand ride. MORAL HAZARD had speed a bit off the rail and dueled for the lead, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch, inched away on the last turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch and just held second. OUTSIDE SHOT pulled his way between horses then stalked inside, bid along the rail into the last turn, stalked again, re-bid along the fence in the stretch and was edged for second. NUMBER ONE EDITION chased three deep then off the rail, angled in some for the final turn and lacked the needed rally. ROAD TO THE THRONE chased outside then between horses, found the inside on the final backstretch and did not rally. VALE broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground to no avail. WARREN'S DEPUTY stalked off the rail then between foes, dropped back outside a rival and weakened. MANIFEST DESTINY stalked off the rail then bid outside the runner-up, dropped back into and on the second turn and gave way.
