THIS TUNE CAN HUM had good early speed and dueled inside, kicked clear on the second turn and drew off under some urging and a strong hand ride. QUINTON'S GOLD forced the pace between horses early then outside the winner to the second turn, was no match for that one thereafter but held second. GREY MEMO broke slowly, chased outside, moved up three deep on the backstretch but settled for the show. SEVEN JILLION saved ground early, came off the rail on the backstretch, went between horses into the second turn and lacked a solid late response. HASTY KRIS saved ground chasing the leaders and failed to respond. PACIFIC PRIDE lugged out and steadied into the first turn, chased between horses on the backstretch and weakened. NO CURFEW chased outside a rival early then between foes on the backstretch and gave way. DIABLO HIS DUE forced the early pace three deep, stalked off the rail, dropped back and gave way.
