Footnotes

TREATHERLIKEALADY drifted a bit and steadied into the first turn, stalked toward the inside, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn and proved best under urging. LODI RENAGADE stalked a bit off the rail or between horses, was no match for the winner in the stretch and just held second.. BEING WITH YOU pulled early, angled in and saved ground throughout and just missed the place. SUNNY DAWN had speed between horses then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner on the backstretch and into the second turn and weakened. CHICA'S DUE three deep early, settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. TORI'S SCALAWAG saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn, drifted out and steadied leaving that bend and did not rally. GO FOR LAUNCH settled outside a rival then came out four wide into the second turn, chased three deep, dropped back and gave way. ELITE NINE stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back on the backstretch, gave way and was eased.
