OUR SOUTHERN PEARL settled on three wide path into backstretch, steadily advanced, split foes early on final turn, angled to the rail in stretch, rallied under strong handling and got up at the wire from inside. YUMMY YUMMY forced the early issue from along the rail, shifted out leaving the backstretch, moved up outside pacesetter, bid inside sixteenth marker, engaged leaders in deep stretch and narrowly missed while three deep at the wire. ANEARLYFIL contested the early pace from outside, gained front, edged away, dug in determinedly through drive but was overhauled in final strides from between rivals. SWEET MEG angled to the rail nearing first turn, dueled from inside, dropped back a bit, then continued inside and weakened. GOLD DIGGER GAL unhurried while saving ground early, swung out into the stretch and only passed tiring foes. KISSY KAT saved ground while chasing the leaders, remained inside and lacked any stretch response. CRAZY CRYSTAL advanced from outside on the backstretch, loomed while three deep nearing final turn, then lugged out around that bend while steadily giving way.
