Footnotes

SWEET SATURDAY contested the early pace, then pressured the pacesetter on two wide path, moved alongside leader on the turn, dueled that rival into submission inside eighth marker, kicked clear and safely held. DERBY HAT settled off the pace then outside foe, advanced two wide around the turn, came out slightly in the drive and whittled gap on winner late. SWISS IN PARIS briefly dueled along the rail then gained short lead, set pressured pace into the turn, was overtaken exiting the turn and weakened from the inside. FUNNY GAL was off step slow, settled inside, hugged the fence into the stretch, came out slightly and bested others. STAR OF THE NIGHT settled outside, chased from off the rail then between horses, came in some into the stretch then drifted out late while never menacing. LULA BAY reserved early, raced along the rail throughout and never reached contention. TRAUMATIZED prominently placed early, tracked dueling duo into the turn while three wide, came out further entering the lane but weakened. SILVIA'S SECRET broke tardily, lagged back from the inside, chased two or three wide and was outrun.
