RIO GOOD quickly stepped to the front, carved out all the fractions, drifted out slightly exiting the last turn but clearly prevailed under strong urging. I FEEL FREE close up early from off the rail, stalked on three then two wide path into the stretch and gamely garnered second. LETHAL INTENT bumped with outside foe leaving the gate, tracked the leader from off the rail, continued three wide around both turns then rallied late to gain the show. DUX forced the early issue from the inside then content to stalk pacesetter from along the rail, remained along the fence throughout but could not hold rival for the show. JEFFERY'S PRIDE bumped at the start, caught four wide into initial turn, continued widest of all down the backstretch, came in bit later but never threatened. GANNICUS was in bit tight early, angled over, chased on two wide trip most of the way and lacked needed response. KATHLEEN'S TOUCH settled inside, saved ground around both turns and never reached contention. NEMRAC reserved from between horses early, drifted out some into first turn, continued either between foes or two wide and was outrun. WHITE STAR LINE was slow to begin, came off the fence, chased three wide into second bend, came in slightly and never menaced.
