WINGLESS FLIGHT had a rail trip forcing or stalking the pace, slipped through to the lead into the second turn, inched clear and held off CLASSY CARA under some left handed urging. CLASSY CARA, broke slowly, settled outside a rival, moved up three deep on the backstretch and second turn, angled to the inside for the stretch and finished well. BLAIR'S FAVORITE, pulled her way to the early lead three deep, angled in some into the first turn, dueled outside the winner into the second turn, then could not match the top pair but held third. STAR'S MILLENNIUM, outside a foe on the first turn, went between rivals on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail and weakened. HIDDEN GREETING, steadied in tight between horses into the first turn, stalked off the rail and also weakened. KEYTOTHEPURSE saved ground within striking distance and had little left for the stretch.
