Footnotes

LUREFAN dueled three deep approaching the first turn and outside a rival through the second turn, inched clear between calls and angled in on the backstretch, battled inside on the final turn and into the stretch and kicked clear again under urging. BANDOFPEARLS angled in and saved ground, moved up three deep into and on the last turn, could not catch the winner but edged a rival for second. JAZZNWITHWINDY took up between horses into the first turn, settled outside a rival, bid again outside the winner on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, then could not match strides and just lost the place. DYNATROL unhurried outside a rival, came out for the stretch and put in a late bid. DAZZLING DIAMONDS angled in and went up inside into the first turn, dueled along the rail into the backstretch, then steadily dropped back and weakened. ST. EULALIA saved ground in midpack to the final turn, went outside a rival on that bend and did not rally. WALL STREET RALLY pulled her way along to stalk the dueling leaders off the rail, dropped back on the third turn and weakened.
