STRIKING COBRA sprinted to an open lead soon after the start, hugged the rail throughout and was never threatened while being kept to task to the end. GHOSTLY GIRL chased the winner from the start, could never close the margin but was clearly second best. MARY SWANSON raced far back to the final turn, found her best stride while saving ground through the turn and rallied mildly along the rail. BROMOS LEAD CHANGE was off slowly, crept up on the backstretch, came three wide through the final turn and closed evenly. STORM REVIEW raced in the middle of the pack, four wide through the final turn and had little response when more was needed. ANTIFREEZETTE chased the the winner to the first turn, drifted out and could not again reach contention. WET SOCKS raced very wide through the first turn and showed little the rest of the way. TOMENCINO was never a factor.
